National Night of Prayer for Life will be once again uniting parishes in an effort to end abortion through Eucharistic Adoration and prayers of reparation. The "hour of Unity" is from 12 midnight to 1 AM EST (11 p.m. to midnight Ellis time), so that all parishes in the four time zones can be linked in prayer across the continent at the same hour.

We will begin each hour with a hymn and several prayers, followed by a rosary and time for silent meditation – all four sets of Mysteries will be prayed.
