Notes from the Priest

National Catholic Schools Week. Catholic Schools Week begins next Sunday, January 30 and ends February 4. A special Mass with the Bishop is tentatively planned for Friday, February 4 at Immaculate Heart of Mary in Hays. We will post the time once we get that information. You are welcome to attend.

Feast of St. Blasé (Blessing of Throats). The Feast of St. Blasé, bishop and martyr, is Thursday, February 3rd. It has been a tradition is to bless people's throats on this feast. To keep the tradition going, we will have the Blessing of the Throats after Mass on Thursday (Children's Mass) and at the Saturday Mass and the two Sunday Masses on February 5th & 6th.

First Reconciliation & First Communion. We have scheduled First Reconciliation and First Communion. First Reconciliation is scheduled for Sunday, February 27 at 3:00pm. First Communion will be Sunday, April 24 (the Sunday after Easter) at the 9:00am Mass.

Liturgy Trivia – Penitential Rite

After the priest and people have announced God's presence by exchanging the greeting, the introductory rites continue with the penitential rite.

In this rite, we prepare to celebrate Word and Eucharist by acknowledging our sinfulness and asking God for forgiveness.

There are three forms of the penitential rite: the recitation of the Confiteor (I confess . . .) by the entire assembly, a brief dialogue between the priest and the people, and a longer dialogue that incorporates the Kyrie Eleison (Lord, have mercy).

There is no set method for choosing which form will be used on any given Sunday, and the third form provides several different sets of invocations which fit different seasons and celebrations.

The penitential rite ends with an absolution wherein the priest asks God to forgive the sins of the gathered community and bring us to everlasting life.
