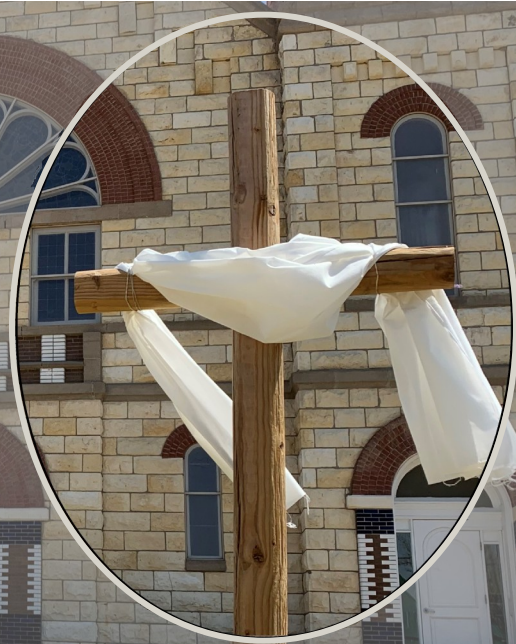

Notes from the Pastor

Faith Sharing Group. Our final Faith Sharing Session is this Sunday, May 22 at 4:00pm. We will be watching session #8 of the video series: "Who Am I to Judge? Responding to Relativism with Logic and Love" led by Dr. Edward Sri.

Blessed Potting Soil and Water. Last Monday at the 5:30pm Mass, in honor of St. Isidore (whose feast day is May 15), a container of potting soil and a container of water were blessed. There is still blessed soil and water available on a table in the back of the church. You may take what you need to sprinkle in your garden or fields.

Mission Coop Weekend. Next weekend, May 28/29, was our scheduled "annual" mission coop appeal weekend, when a priest or lay missionary come to the parish to give a talk about their mission and the parish takes up a special collection for them. This year, someone from the Maryknoll Lay Missioners was scheduled to be here to give a in-person appeal. However, they are having a hard time finding one of their missionaries from overseas to return to the US for the appeal. So, instead, they have asked if I would read a written appeal statement on their behalf during Mass. A special collection will take place at all masses.

Memorial Day Service. The annual Memorial Day Service for St. Mary's Cemetery will be following the service at St. John's church which begins around 9:00am, Monday, May 30.

Totus Tuus—"Summer Youth Program." This is scheduled for the week of July 17-22. This is for students who completed 1st-12th grades. Grades 1-6 meet during the day. Grades 7-12 meet in the evening.

2022 Diocesan Men's Conference is set for Saturday, August 13th, at Immaculate Heart of Mary parish in Hays. The theme is "Guarding the Faith!" Keynote speaker is Dr. Mario Enzler, former Swiss Guard, and renowned Catholic speaker.

Value Them Both Amendment to the Kansas Constitution. Kansans value both mothers and babies, but a Kansas Supreme Court case has created a nearly unlimited "right" to abortion in our state constitution and has endangered any regulations on the abortion industry. The Value Them Both Amendment affirms that Kansas still want to be able to protect both mothers and babies by placing basic restriction on the abortion industry. The Value Them Both Amendment simply ensures that there can be at least some limits on the abortion industry and that you are not forced to subsidize the industry with your tax dollars. We do not want Kansas to become like New York or Colorado, where abortions are allowed up to the moment of birth.
