Notes from the Pastor

Snake in the Church Attic? When checking out the attic in the church for leaks, I was reminded of a two-inch hole in the roof (not a big problem with rain because the roof shingles partially cover it), but, apparently, an open door for other visitors. After finding a couple of "fairly recent" dead birds, a live one flying around, a snake perched on the edge of the north vent door (yes a snake!), and extra bat droppings along the walking path, it was imperative to block the hole, but an obvious challenge to reach 15-feet with no ladder. With a little inspiration from the Holy Spirit and with a 12-foot extendable paint stick, a 6-inch paint roller, a 6-inch block of wood, and construction glue,



I was able to press the block into place (see pictures). The block had to be placed after dark to ensure the bats using that hole to exit were gone. High Plains Roofing will eventually fix it from the outside.

I have strung eight, 4-foot, LED linkable lights spaced out along the center walkway and five on the south walkway. So, it is not as scary than when only a flashlight was used. I'm planning on putting a string of lights on the north walkway too.

We do have bats that live up there somewhere and have a way of coming and going (I believe it is on the north side). I'm not sure how many we have. It may not be a big problem, unless they are populating. They have been living there for a while, I'm sure.

It may require a brave soul to sit in the attic and watch as they merge from their sleep to make their way outside. If we can locate the place (or places) they leave and enter (and if we can get to those places), we can block up the hole(s), so they will be forced to find another home... They don't bother you during the day, and I don't see any "hanging" around as I walk down the center. But I don't want the problem to get worse.
