Notes from the Pastor

Peter's Pence Collection is next weekend June 25-26. The Peter's Pence collection unites us in solidarity to the Holy Sea, and its works of charity to those in need. A copy of the Bishop's letter supporting this collection is enclosed.

More Maintenance Updates:

Utility Shed. The Race for Education project this year is to build a 24' x 16' utility shed (on the north side of school, replacing the small one that was there) for extra storage. Once the foundation is laid, we will begin to build it. Cletus Gross, our school custodian and maintenance person, is spearheading the project. I'll help out where I can be of assistance. We have desks and chairs stored in the church basement (the room where the east furnace is located) that will be moved over, so we can open up that space. Catholic Mutual wrote us up on that location because we don't have easy access to an electrical box in that area.

Handicap Ramp. The handicap ramp on the east side of the rectory will be replaced. The wood is "warping" and not as safe as it should be. Catholic Mutual wrote this up in their report as something that needed to be addressed. Actually, I pointed it out to them and told them that we were planning to replace it, so they documented it their report. Greg Augustine is going to spearhead the project, with help from a friend and fellow Knights of Columbus.
