Notes from the Pastor

Auction Updates. The auction is now two weeks away.

- **Online Auction bidding and Pre-bidding for Silent Auction** items begin Tuesday, September 13 at 12:00am.
- **Pre-bidding for Silent** auction items will end Thursday, September 15 at 11:00pm, so, we can get bid sheets printed for Saturday. The start amount on the bid sheets will be pre-bid amounts (if any). To continue bidding on silent auction items, you will need to be in-person or have someone present at the auction bidding for you.
- **Bidding for Online auction** items will end Saturday, September 17 at 12:00pm (Noon), so that we can focus on the Silent and Live auctions. Online items can be picked up Sunday if you are not attending in-person.
- At this time, we are planning to **live-stream** the Live Auction and allow online bidding for items in the Live auction, in addition to in-person bidding. There will be link to the Live Auction on our website. We are using the Farmland Auction/Pfeifer Brothers auction software, which has the capability for online bidding. This is new venture for us, so please be patient. We don't expect a lot of online bidding this year, but wish to include this feature for future auctions.

 - Select "Parish Life" menu option, then "Parish Event" and "Parish Auction"
 - Click on "Link to 2022 Online Auction Website"
- **Previewing online auction items.** Some have expressed an interest in being able to preview online auctions items prior to start of bidding. We are planning to set up tables in the basement of church with those items. Viewing times will be Saturday and Sunday, September 9 and 10 after the weekend Mass, and, perhaps sometime Monday and Tuesday (by appointment). Call the Parish Office for a private viewing of the items.

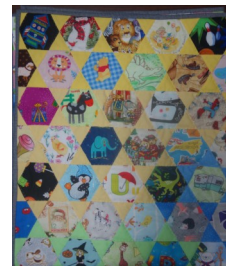
