Notes from the Pastor

Priest's Convocation. Our annual priests' convocation is scheduled for September 19 through September 23 at the Savior Pastoral Center in Kansas City. I'm planning on coming back early, Wednesday afternoon, because of my Confirmation and RCIA classes. Mass on Monday will be at 8:10am instead of 5:30pm, and there will be no Masses on Tuesday and Wednesday. I hope to be back for Thursday and Friday Masses. I'll keep you posted.

Auction Updates. The auction is now one week away.

- **Previewing online auction items.** We have online auction items set up in the church basement for previewing after all Masses this weekend. Doors will be locked during the day. We will keep it set up until Tuesday evening. If you wish to stop by some time Sunday afternoon, Monday, or Tuesday for private viewing, I'll be glad to open up the room for you. Just call to make sure I'm around.
- Online auction bidding and pre-bidding for silent auction items begin Tuesday, September 13 at 12:00am.
- Pre-bidding for Silent auction items will end Thursday, September 15 at 11:00pm. To continue bidding on silent auction items, you will need to be present at the auction or have someone in-person bidding for you.
- Bidding for online auction items will end Saturday, September 17 at 12:00pm, Noon, so that we can focus on the silent and live auctions.
- Mass on Saturday will be at 4:00pm.
- Doors to open at 5:00pm.
- At this time, we are planning to live streaming the Live auction and allow online bidding for Live auction items in addition to in-person bidding. We are still working out the details, but hope to be able to allow for online bidding for live auction items. There will be link to the live auction on our website. Again, we don't expect a lot of online bidding this year, but wish to include this feature (at least try it out) for future auctions.
