Notes from the Pastor

All Saints Day. Tuesday, November 1 is the Feast of All Saints. For our regular Monday night Mass at 5:30pm, I'll celebrate as the vigil of the Feast of All Saints. In other words, the 5:30pm Mass on Monday will count as fulfilling your holyday obligation. Masses on Tuesday, November 1, will be at 7:00am, 8:10am (with our school children) and 7:00pm.

Cemetery Prayer Service. The Cemetery Prayer Service that we traditionally have every year will be Sunday, November 6 (The Sunday after All Souls Day which is November 2). It will be held after our 9:00am Mass at the cemetery.

Remembering Prayer Service. Our Remembering Prayer Service is next Sunday, November 6 at 4:00pm. Everyone is welcome to attend.

Catechism Trivia

379. What are the principal human virtues? The principal human virtues are called the *cardinal* virtues, under which all the other virtues are grouped and which are the hinges of a virtuous life. The cardinal virtues are: prudence, justice, fortitude, and temperance. *Further reading: CCC 1805, 1834*

380. What is prudence? Prudence disposes reason to discern in every circumstance our true good and to choose the right means for achieving it. Prudence guides the other virtues by pointing out their rule and measure. *Further reading: CCC 1806, 1835*

381. What is justice? Justice consists in the firm and constant will to give to others their due. Justice toward God is called "the virtue of religion." *Further reading: CCC 1807, 1836*

382. What is fortitude? Fortitude assures firmness in difficulties and constancy in the pursuit of the good. It reaches even to the ability of possibly sacrificing one's own life for a just cause. *Further reading: CCC 1808, 1837*

383. What is temperance? Temperance moderates the attraction of pleasures, assures the mastery of the will over instincts and provides balance in the use of created goods. *Further reading: CCC 1809, 1838*
