**The Feast of Christ the King** is next Sunday. This feast marks the end of the liturgical year. Advent begins the following Sunday (November 27).

**Pictures of the Sacred Heart of Jesus and the Divine Mercy.** Blessed, framed pictures of the Sacred Heart of Jesus and the Divine Mercy (that I matted and framed) are available in back of the church for your home or to give to someone for their home.
