Note from the Pastor

Selection of New Parish Council Members. We are in the process of selecting new parish council members (3-4 persons). If you remember, we moved from an election process to a discernment process in our selection of parish council members. The discernment process is a more effective and theologically grounded selection process. Discernment of members involves prayer, reflection, open conversation, and, most importantly, openness to the Holy Spirit working in our midst to call forth designated candidates.

The Parish Council members are prayerfully considering those whom they feel would be good parish leaders. Each member will submit a list of names (3-4 for a male and 3-4 for a female). Parishioners can also submit names for discernment. These lists will then be tallied. Those whose name appear multiple times would be discerned further. Based on the outcome of the discernment, the pastor would personally invite parishioners to serve on the parish council.

School Project Update. Installation of lights and ceiling tiles in the hallways are completed. The floors in the hallway will be finished by Tuesday. Lights in the 4th grade and Kindergarten rooms still need to be finished, probably after harvest. Thanks to Ernie Pfeifer, Jr. and Darrell Augustine for their work in installing lights this past week. Work for installing the ceiling tiles in the cafeteria has began and will continue next week. We are still researching options for HVAC systems in the classrooms. A ductless mini-split system is what we are considering. Mitsubishi and Gree are two top brands. Mitsubishi has a light commercial system that will heat to 100% capacity at -13F below 0. Gree has a similar system. We will be doing a comparison of various criteria of interest (e.g., sound rating, efficiency ratings, warranty, cost, expected life cycle, etc.). We plan to keep the current furnaces (at least for a while) for backup heat in case we need them on cold days. However, we don't get -13F below 0 weather that often.

Note: We removed the 2x4 fluorescent light fixtures and bulbs from the classrooms. If anyone has a use for any of them or can salvage any parts, feel free to take them. They will be sitting against the dumpster on the circle drive between the school and church.
