Note from the Pastor

School Project Update. The floors in the hallway are finished. Ceiling tiles in cafeteria are installed. We had some extra tile, so we replaced the 2x4 tiles in the 1st and 2nd grade rooms with 2x2 tiles. Many were wrapped and sagging, probably due to humidity over time. The 2x2 tend to work better. The ones we installed also have a higher rating on sag and moisture resistance. Also, there was a musty smell in the 1st grade room, due, we believe, to past water damage. The 1st grade teacher said it has been there for several years. Some ceiling tiles had been removed, exposing the old insulation. We believe the smell is coming from the water damage tiles and exposed insulation. We will be putting sheetrock over the exposed and damaged area to, hopefully, stop the musty smell. We will cut the sheetrock into 2x4 sections, since the grid work prevents us from putting up full sheets.

We are getting closer to making a decision for the HVAC systems for the classrooms. We are leaning toward the Gree Sapphire ductless split model. It has the features we are looking for and can deliver up to 90% heating capacity of -22F. We also have a rep in Hays for Gree, which is better than the other brand we were considering (Mitsubishi) who closest rep is Salina.

Reminders:

Selection of New Parish Council Members. We are in the process of selecting new parish council members (3-4 persons). If you remember we moved from an election process to a discernment process in our selection of parish council members. The discernment process is a more effective and theologically grounded selection process. Discernment of members involves prayer, reflection, open conversation, and, most importantly, openness to the Holy Spirit working in our midst to call forth designated candidates.

The Parish Council members are prayerfully considering those whom they feel would be good parish leaders. Each member will submit a list of names (3- 4 for a male and 3-4 names for a female). Parishioners can also submit names for discernment. These lists will then be tallied. Those whose name appear multiple times would be discerned further. Based on the outcome of the discernment, the pastor would personally invite parishioners to serve on the parish council.
